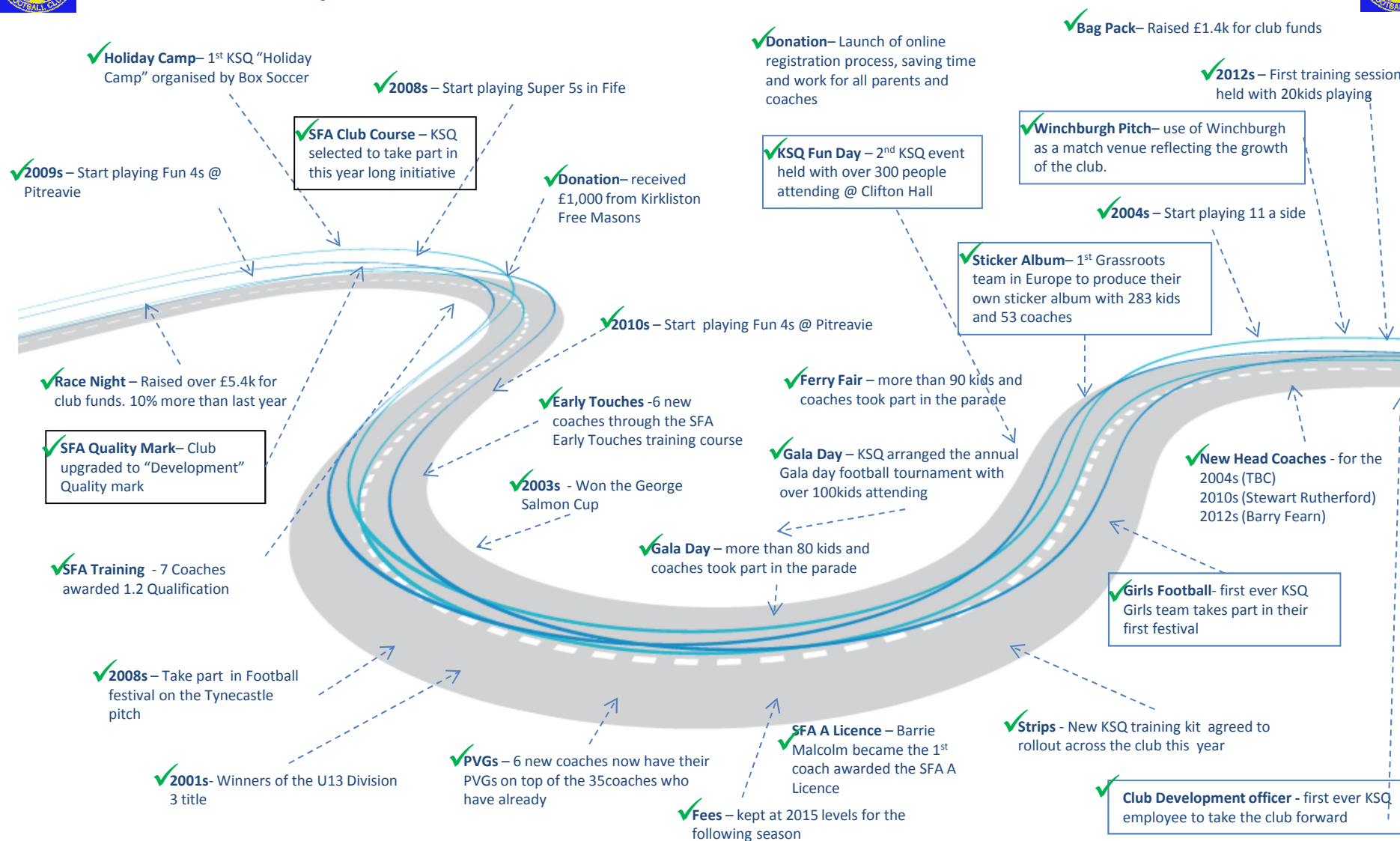




KSQ 2015/2016 – Our Year
