To provide **equal** playing time in games as long as **effort** and **conduct** remains at the clubs expected standard.

To provide at least 1 night a week training for all players, while **encouraging** players to **develop** abilities in their own time.

To encourage **healthy attitudes**, **respect for others** and promote **teamwork**.

To provide an **open**, **honest** and **approachable** environment for parents/carers to **discuss** and **resolve** any issues identified.

To ensure that everyone associated with KSQ (players, parents and coaches) acts in accordance with “**Positive Coaching Scotland Guidelines**”
